

## Interpretations, Rule-Interpretation, Questions for interpretation

Want of clearness	Interpretation IFAA
- How many arrows can be shot?	As described at the corresponding event
- In 3-arrow-rounds: the make-up arrows must also be shot also in ascending order?	
- When e.g. arrows with the same numbering have been shot, which arrow will be scored and in which way?	
- What happens when more than the allowed number of arrows have been shot? E.g. at the 1-arrow round a second arrow, in the 2-arrow round a third arrow and in the 3-arrow round a 4th arrow?	
- Are binoculars allowed at this EBHC?	
- Which precautions resp regulations will be made for animal targets where the scoring zones are not clearly defined? E.g. Eleven-targets often have between the legs green parts, etc	
- Are all targets shot in pairs at this ,EBHC?	
- Is it possible that the number of archers shooting at the same time may be changed at every target? Is it possible that both athletes can shoot from the same marker, in case one of them should have a disadvantage when shooting from a separate marker?	
- Can the Target Captain allow an archer in case of equipment failure to leave the group, in order to repair his equipment? - What is the allowed max. time?	
- Which practicable possibilities does an archer have in case he is of the opinion that the decision of the Target Captain is not correct?	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Can an archer who has gone backwards e.g. 1 m (not in direction of the target) and is reconsidering his decision, come back on his decision still shoot another arrow (page 44) ***</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- What possibilities does an archer have when the organiser does not respect the rules? E.g. shootinglane is not free, or the target can only partly be seen, or the distances are not correct?</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Who is pulling the arrows when they have to be pulled prematurely as there are too many arrows in the target?</li> </ul>	<p>The athletes who have already shot go together to the target and control each other.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Is there a team-competition?</li> </ul>
