## Mixed Team Field Rules for the Test Event May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 in Zwettl

### 1. Team composition and registration

A Mixed Team consists of two athletes from one division. In the first instance a mixed team consists of a female and a male athlete. However, as this event is a test event, also teams of the same sex can compete if there are no more athletes of the other sex available.

Bow classes

- Instinctive bow
- Barebow bow
- Compound bow
- Recurve bow

The top eight Mixed Teams of each division will shoot Quarter-Final matches.

The event will not be held for any division for which fewer than four Mixed Teams are registered.

#### **Registration**

Mixed Teams have to be registered before the start of the Qualification Round of Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

### 2. Ranking

The Mixed Teams are seeded according to their positions as determined by their total score (for ties 6's and 5's) in the Qualification Round of Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 (Match Pay Chart Teams, Quarter-Finals).

### 3. Schedule

#### **Numbers of targets**

4 marked targets in the Quarter-Finals

4 marked targets in the Semi-Finals

4 marked targets in the Finals

#### **Target faces and distances**

The Mixed Team Rounds consist of four marked targets in each match with marked distances.

In each round the targets can be placed at the organizers wishes. However, all target faces (20/40/60/80) must be used in any order. There should be a mix of short, medium and long distances.

#### **Number of arrows and time limits**

The time limit for four arrows (two by each athlete) is 160 seconds.

### ***Shoot-off***

An end of two arrows (one by each athlete) shoot-off for score. The limit for a Mixed Team shoot-off shall be 80 seconds.

### ***Order of shooting and rotation***

Both teams will shoot at the same time.

Only one athlete from each team may be on the peg at any time and shoots one arrow.

After every arrow the athletes must rotate.

### ***Questions about the value of an arrow***

If the athletes cannot agree on the value of an arrow, a Judge shall be called to decide on the value of the arrow.
