No Archer is allowed to take part in the tournament in a state affected by alcohol. Alcohol controls can be carried out by authorized persons.
However, it is the archer's responsibility to adhere to the anti-doping agreements.

All penalty fees which may follow a positive doping-test have to be taken over by the athlete.
